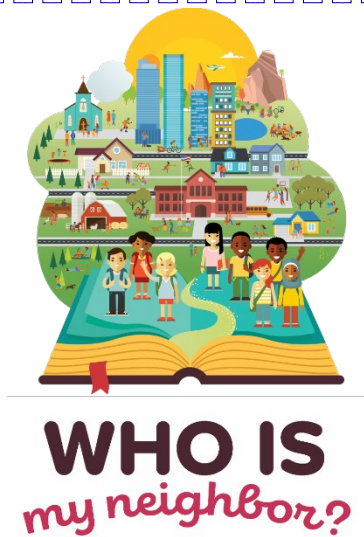




Daily Theme: God loves everyone!

Mission Station

We talked today about how relationships are easy to break but more difficult to put back together and how God is there to help us along the way. We did ‘banana surgery’, symbolizing how we can sometimes cut down our neighbors with our words or actions, and then the difficulty of repairing our relationships with one another afterwards. Ask your children about how they ‘healed’ their banana after cutting it up into four pieces! The children shared ideas about how we can help heal each other when we’ve been hurt, and how important God’s love is to help us with the parts that are really hard.

Science Station
